### SATURDAY, June 12

1000-1100 **Arrive McClellan Field (MCC)** (Van takes everyone to O' Club at 1100)

1130-1245 **Lunch at Officer's Club** (Van takes everyone to Museum)

1300 -1600 **Aerospace Museum of California** - \$10/person

**NASA's Hubble Space Telescope Traveling Exhibit** is a 2,200 square-foot exhibit immersing visitors in the magnificence and mystery of the Hubble mission and introduces the James Webb Space Telescope. The exhibit features a scale model of the Hubble Space Telescope as well as several "satellite" units not only providing viewers with a hands-on experience with the same technology that allows Hubble to gaze at distant galaxies, but also feature Hubble's contributions to the exploration of planets, stars, galaxies and the universe.

**Outdoor Airpark** Visit the 35 historical aircraft from a WWII D-Day Invasion paratroop C-53 carrier to the movie Top Gun's F-14 Tomcat. You can walk around, walk under and touch all aircraft in the museum's collection.

**Aircraft Engines** from the earliest piston engines to rocket engines the entire collection allows you to get up close, touch and interact with these magnificent pieces of aviation and aerospace history.

1630-1800 **Hotel Check-In Holiday Inn** 300 J Street, Old Sac (Van takes everyone to hotel) or **The Sheraton Hotel on J Street .7 miles from Holiday Inn**

1800 **Drinks and Dinner** – Firehouse Restaurant – 1112 2<sup>nd</sup> St, Old Sac (2 block walking distance from/to hotel) **OR** Rio Café on the Sacramento River (or for late night drinks) **OR** Delta King River Boat (for late night drinks)

### SUNDAY, June 13

0900-1030 **Breakfast at Steamers Bakery & Café** - 101 K St, Old Sac (3 short block walk from hotel)

1030 – Everyone meets at hotel lobby for van transportation to next venue (Check out from hotel before)

1100- 1400 – **Sneak Peek- SMUD Museum of Science and Curiosity OR California Railroad Museum** (at north end of Old Sac) \$12/person. Also available is a 50-minute round-trip ride along the scenic Sacramento River where you will experience railroading as it was in the early part of the 20<sup>th</sup> century pulled by a historic steam or diesel locomotive. Cost \$15 in addition to museum entrance.

1400 Van departs for return trip to MCC – ETA 1430
